Yearbooks:	\$28.00 per book
Graphing Calculators:	All math programs require students to use graphing calculators. You may purchase them at any electronics store. We recommend a TI-83 plus, TI-83 Plus Silver, TI-84 Plus, TI84 Plus Silver, TI-86, TI-89, TI-89 Titanium TI- <i>n</i> spire (with TI 84 Keypad only; the TI- <i>n</i> spire keypad is not approved)
Lock:	Students are responsible for providing their own lock for student lockers and some form of combination lock is strongly recommended. Students are encouraged to bring their lock with them to registration evening and place it on the locker they will be assigned.
Bible:	All Students should bring a modern translation of the Bible (NIV, RSV) to be available for use in both devotions and classes.
Textbook Rentals:	Textbook rental is included in the ESCE student fees. This will cover textbooks used in every course. If a textbook is damaged or lost, the cost of repairing or replacing the book will be charged to the student.
Citadel/ Drama:	All students have the opportunity to attend a Citadel performance and the ECS high school drama as an enhancement of the English curriculum. Citadel = Grade 10 costs are included in ESCE student fees, Grade 11 (\$33.00), Grade 12 (\$33.00). ECS HS Drama = \$10.00 per student.

Payment options for Music Tour:

If Student is fundraising:

1. One cheque for \$400 paid at time of registration
2. Two post-dated cheques for \$200 each dated September 30, 2010 and November 30, 2010
3. Four post-dated cheques for \$100 each dated September 30, 2010, October 31, 2010, November 30, 2010, and, December 31, 2010.

If student is not fundraising:

1. One cheque for \$600 paid at time of registration.
2. Two post-dated cheques for \$300 each dated September 30, 2010 and November 30, 2010.
3. Six post-dated cheques for \$100 each dated September 30, 2010, October 31, 2010, November 30, 2010, December 31, 2010, January 31, 2011, and, February 28, 2011.

Students may opt out of the tour before Christmas without financial penalty – postdated cheques will be returned if you and your parent(s) **notify Mrs. Huculak in writing by December 16, 2011.**

Club/Team Fees: Clubs and teams are optional activities that occur throughout the year.
