

Grade 7 Complementary Course Information:

Music: Band – All Grade 7 students will take band 125 minutes per week. They will build basic instrumental skills individually and in groups. In noon hour choir (optional) students will be given the opportunity to praise God with their voices and be part of a worship team. The year will consist of many small & large performances at various events. Students will be required to rent or own an instrument; you might consider talking to relatives to see if you could “borrow” a band instrument for the year. Arrangements will be negotiated in early September and more information will be provided on the first day of school.

Art: All grade 7 students will take art, 125 minutes per week. They will learn and use the elements and principles of art. They will explore their God-given talents through a variety of media. (Ms. Kesslering).

 - Tour fee/transportation costs – local events throughout the year

 - **Athletic fees** (extra-curricular) vary depending on tournament and program needs
 - Junior teams approximately \$70 per sport
 - Senior teams approximately \$70-110 per sport
 - Uniform rental/replacement costs \$10 per player
