

Grade 7 Supply List

Students do not need an agenda since we issue to all Grade 7 students, included in program fees.

- **inside shoes** (well-fitting **non-marking** gym shoes; worn exclusively in gym & indoors)
- **gym clothing** (shorts [not cut-offs] and t-shirt, track suit, or sweats)
- **ball point pens** (red and blue)
- **highlighters** (4 different colours)
- **pencils (at least 24), pencil crayons, erasers, pencil sharpener**

Grade 7 Complementary Course Information:

Band – All Grade 7 students will take band 125 minutes per week. They will build basic instrumental skills individually and in groups. The year will consist of many small and large performances at various events. Students will be required to rent or own an instrument; you might consider talking to relatives to see if you could “borrow” a band instrument for the year.
