Title: Society Membership

Policy

Society membership is available only to those who accept, sign and will support the Society's Statement of Faith.

Society memberships are available to those who accept the basis of the Society as stated in the By-laws:

1. Any person who has attained the age of eighteen years, who is in agreement with the basis of the Society as herein before set out, who desires to aid in the achievement of the objectives of the Society and signs the Statement of Faith, which summarizes the basis of the Society as found in clause 2 above shall be considered an inactive (nonvoting) member.
2. Continuous active membership is dependent upon continued support of the Statement of Faith and regular financial support by way of donation to the Society in the amount of \$25.00 or more per single or \$50.00 or more per couple per year; a \$25.00 minimum annual tax receiptable donation is required per single or \$50.00 per couple. The annual minimum donation is waived as long as members have children attending Edmonton Christian School, in Kindergarten through grade 12.
3. Only active members are entitled to vote at membership meetings.
4. Any member may withdraw from membership in the Society by notifying the Society office.
5. Any member may be expelled by vote of the Board for reason of any act found to be in conflict with the basis of the Society.
6. Members will have access to an appeal mechanism comprised of four (4) active (voting) Society members.
