STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Edmonton Christian Northeast School uses the services of Write-on Stationery Supplies Inc. to acquire student materials for each school year. Order forms and information letters will be going home in the next week. Students are required to supply their own materials for the school year but we place a student supply order for you. From grades 1 – 6 parents are provided a supply list, appropriate to the grade of their child(ren). Forms also available on SchoolZone (shortly). Each list has 4 parts:

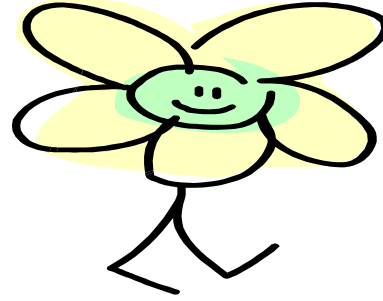


- 1) required supplies -parents need to take note of these required supplies and purchase these **on your own**.
- 2) a basic package—supplies that are teacher specific, consumable essentials (i.e. special scribblers) help provide consistency and make the classroom run smoothly and efficiently when each student has the proper materials.
- 3) recyclable supplies (i.e. pencil sharpeners, pencil crayons, etc.) are not as sensitive to individual teacher expectation.
- 4) vital statistics are required to purchase, label and identify your pre-packaged supplies for your child (ren). Children are also assured of having the “correct” supplies as needed in their classroom.

If your son/daughter uses all the supplies more quickly than expected (loss, waste, etc.), you would be responsible for providing what was needed. All students **need these supplies**. The order form needs to be returned to the school with payment by **June 25, 2010** with cash, your credit card number or a cheque (written to Write-On Stationery). Cheques can be post dated to July 1, 2010. This is your supply list if you don't order keep it to purchase your supplies.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Generally, people make their first impressions based on appearance. We want to display a Christ-like appearance. Therefore, we must concern ourselves with proper attire that demonstrates a respect for God, for others and for self.

Students are expected to dress in a manner that is reflective of the current standards of the Christian community. This would require that students have apparel that is suitable for school work and school activities and would include the minimum standards of neatness, cleanliness and modesty. This would exclude dress where undergarments are exposed, exclude the wearing of spaghetti straps, forbid the baring of midriffs and forbid the wearing of hats or other headgear in school buildings. Students would be prohibited from wearing clothing with messages and graphics that endorse or depict subjects such as violence, pornography, alcohol and smoking. (Edmonton Christian School policy)
